Project Summary

The scheme as designed by Wilson Mason and Partners involves the creation of a new, updated and revitalised multifunctional space and facilities in the library on the 1st floor at 23 Queen Square House. It has a central rare archive unit, which consists of steel structure and special shelving to accommodate some artefacts and archives within a controlled environment. It also includes glazed cabinets and mobile racking. The work also involves building new plinths and acoustic louvres on the roof to accommodate new condensers.
